Revision of Duty Call-up Allowance for Home Guards from
Rs.75/- to Rs.90/- only per head per day.

Sir,

In supersession to this Department G.O.No.1227/CD, dated
23-6-2006, I am directed to convey the sanction of the Governor to
the revision of the rates of the Duty Call-up Allowance for Home
Guards from Rs.75/- (Rupees seventy five) to Rs.90/- (Rupees ninety) only
per head per day of 8 (eight) hours or more per day from the date of
issue of this order.

Under the existing policy the expenditure on Duty Call-up
Allowance is payable by the Agency ~~at~~ at whose instance the Home
Guards are called up for duty.

The services of Home Guards can be utilised for a maximum
period of 220 (two hundred and twenty) days in a year.

This has been concurred in by Finance Department vide
their V.O.R.No.358/CS-I, dated 11-6-08.
