WHEREAS, Dr. Rajendra Prasad Sharma, IPS (RR:1986) at present D.G. of Police, Odisha has been appointed as Non-Judicial Member of the Lokayukta, Odisha vide G.A & P.G Deptt. Notification dated 21794/Gen dated 05.08.2019.

AND WHEREAS, Dr. Sharma, IPS at present D.G. of Police, Odisha, Cuttack has applied for voluntary retirement from the IPS w.e.f. 08.08.2019 A.N. vide his letter No.95/RES dated 06.08.2019 to enable him to take up his new assignment.

AND WHEREAS, sub-Rule (2) of Rule 16 of AIS (DCRB) Rule, 1958 provides that a member of Service may after giving at least 3(three) months previous notice in writing to the State Government to retire from service on the date on which such member completes 30 (thirty) years of qualifying service or attains 50(fifty) years age or on any date thereafter to be specified in the notice.

AND WHEREAS, the date of birth and date of entry into Indian Police Service of Dr. R.P. Sharma, IPS being 15.05.1960 and 29.06.1989 respectively, Dr. R.P. Sharma, IPS has attained 50(fifty) years age and completed 30(thirty) years of qualifying service and Dr. Sharma, IPS is eligible to retire from Government service voluntarily under Sub-Rule (2) of Rule 16 of AIS (DCRB) Rule, 1958.

AND WHEREAS, the State Government are empowered under Rule 16 (2) of AIS (DCRB) Rule, 1958 to accept the application for voluntary retirement of the IPS officers belonging to the State cadre concerned and as per second proviso of Sub-Rule (2) of Rule 16 of AIS (DCRB) Rule, 1958, the State Government concerned, if satisfied and for reasons to be recorded in writing relax the mandatory period of three months previous notice.

AND WHEREAS, in exercise of the powers conferred on them under Sub-Rule (2) of Rule 16 of AIS (DCRB) Rule, 1958, the State Government have been pleased to condone the mandatory notice period of three months in case of Dr. R.P. Sharma, IPS for his voluntary retirement from service.

NOW THEREFORE, Dr. R.P. Sharma, IPS at present D.G. of Police, Odisha is allowed to retire voluntarily from the Indian Police Service under Sub-Rule (2) of Rule 16 of AIS (DCRB) Rules, 1958 with effect from

08.08.2019 A.N. He will be entitled to all retirement benefits as per rule under AIS (DCRB) Rule, 1958.
