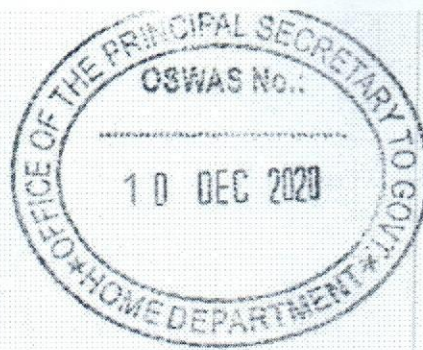

Sir,

The proposed draft of the Odisha Civil Services (Method of conduction of
physical standard measurement & physical efficiency test and preparation of select list on
the basis of marks obtained in the written test) Rules, 2020 provides for:

1. Conducting of physical standard measurement and physical efficiency test
after conducting the written test.
2. The physical standard measurement and physical efficiency test shall be of
qualifying nature and no marks for such tests to be counted for merit
position.
3. No marks for career assessment at the time of initially recruitment.

I am directed to inform that, broadly Odisha Police has no objection on any
of these points.

However, in view of the nature of duties of the Police, in some cases of
recruitment, physical efficiency test marks may be required. Hence, a clause may be
provided in the rules for providing exemption by the Government in appropriate cases.
