Sub: Establishment of Crime Against Women & Children Wing (CAW & CW) in the State

Sir,

I am directed to convey the sanction of Governor for creation of 62 posts in various ranks, in the newly created Crime Against Women & Children Wing (CAW & CW) in the State under CID-CB, Odisha established for the purpose of synergizing the efforts being made by the various units in the State to prevent and prosecute crimes against women and children under supervision of a single umbrella, in the level of Pay mentioned against each and other allowances as sanctioned by Government from time to time.

2. These posts are being created in lieu of immediate abolition of equal number of posts in four different Establishments under Odisha Police as indicated below read with details as at Annexure.

3. The 60 regular posts as detailed above are to be created with the stipulation that, the recruitment shall be made in a transparent manner following the relevant recruitment rules and provisions of ORV Act. The base-level posts meant for direct recruitment shall be filled up on contractual basis initially following the relevant recruitment rules and provision of ORV Act. as well as the stipulations contained in erstwhile G.A Department Notification No.32010/Gen. dated 12.11.2013 read with Notification No.19574/Gen. dated 12.09.2017 and Notification No.1147/Gen. dated 17.01.2014 read with Notification No.19569/Gen. dated 12.09.2017. Their service condition and emoluments of posts so created will be governed by the said Notification of G.A. Department.

The promotional posts, if any, are to be filled up observing relevant Rules and ORV Act.

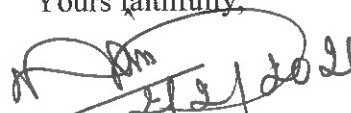
4. The two domain experts shall be engaged on contractual fixed tenure basis. It would be necessary to engage fresh experts with updated domain knowledge periodically by replacing the existing personnel and there shall not be any provision of renewal of contract. After expiry of the tenure of the domain experts, fresh personnel having updated knowledge will have to be engaged. Home Department shall workout the remuneration structure of the domain experts and take concurrence of Finance Department in this regard. Besides, the contract with domain

experts shall be prepared by Home Department in consultation with Law Department and vetted by the Finance Department so as to eliminate future litigation for regularization.

5. This has been concurred in by the Finance Department in their File No. FIN-GS1-CADRE-0025-2020.

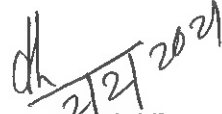
