**Sub: Re-engagement of retired Police Ministerial Officers on Contractual basis
with consolidated remuneration**

Sir,

In inviting a reference to the letters on the subject cited above, I am directed to say that Government after careful consideration has been pleased to allow for extension of tenure of contractual engagement of 09 retired Police Ministerial Officers of State Police Headquarters for a further period of one year (2nd. spell) with same terms & conditions as agreed earlier.

Further, re-engagement of another 10 Retired Police Ministerial Officer of State Police Headquarters is allowed on contractual basis as OSD against the vacant posts of A.S.O for a period of one year from the date of their joining or till the vacancies are filled up on regular basis whichever is earlier as per the terms & conditions enshrined in the erstwhile G.A Department Resolution No.23750/Gen. dated 27.08.2014.

The consolidated remuneration of these contractual personnel are to be fixed at Rs.13,000/- per month .

This has been concurred by Finance Department in file no. FIN-GS1-CADRE-0026-2019.

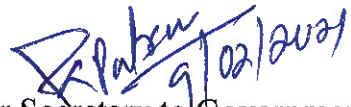

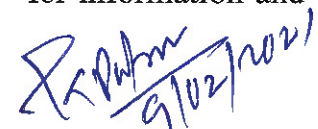
