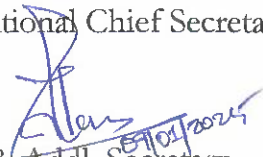

LEGISLATION

Bill No. 100
An Act to amend the Criminal Code

Enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty in Council, at Ottawa, this 10th day of June, 1988.

Her Majesty the Queen, by and with the advice and consent of the Senate and of the House of Commons, do hereby enact the following provisions:

1. The Criminal Code is amended by adding the following section:
