Sub:- Sanction of financial up-gradations under the MACPs/ RACPs in favour of Correctional Officers of Jail Organization.

In inviting a reference to your Letter No. 10514 dated 02.07.2025 on the subject cited above, I am directed to say that after careful consideration of the recommendations of the Departmental Screening Committee and on examination of the service records of the following officers of the Correctional Service Cadre of Jail Organization, the following financial upgradation under the provision of the RACP/MACP Scheme are hereby allowed.

SL	Name of Officer	Recommendation
1	Shri Amir Kumar Nathsharma, CPO	Eligible for 3 rd MACP w.e.f. 01.10.2023 on completion of 30 years of continuous service, with admissible pay fixation benefits under Rule-12 of the ORSP Rules, 2017. No further pay fixation shall be allowed at the time of his subsequent promotion to the post of Chief Probation Officer w.e.f. 01.08.2024, and his pay shall be regulated accordingly.
2	Smt. Gundala Sharmila, RPO (Retired)	Eligible for: (i) 2 nd RACP w.e.f. 01.10.2013 with admissible pay fixation benefits as per Finance Department clarification Letter No. 5073 dated 13.02.2025. Further, the Pay fixation w.e.f. 01.01.2016 shall be made in conformity with the provisions enshrined in ORSP Rules, 2017, no further pay fixation shall be allowed at the time of her subsequent promotion to the post of Regional Probation Officer, and her pay shall be regulated in the appropriate level accordingly.; and (ii) 3 rd MACP w.e.f. 01.10.2023 with admissible pay fixation benefits under Rule-12 of the ORSP Rules, 2017.

3	Smt. Basantilata Singh, RPO	Eligible for 2 nd MACP w.e.f. 27.12.2018, with placement in Level-11 of the Pay Matrix and admissible pay fixation benefits under Rule-12 of the ORSP Rules, 2017.
4	Shri Manoj Narayan Sarangi, RPO	Eligible for 2 nd MACP w.e.f. 10.02.2023 on completion of 20 years of service, with placement in Level-11 of the Pay Matrix and admissible pay fixation benefits under Rule-12 of the ORSP Rules, 2017.
5	Shri Nibas Prusti, DPO	Eligible for 2 nd MACP w.e.f. 10.02.2023 on completion of 20 years of service, with placement in Level-11 of the Pay Matrix and admissible pay fixation benefits under Rule-12 of the ORSP Rules, 2017.
6	Shri Debabrata Jena, DPO	Eligible for 2 nd MACP w.e.f. 09.02.2023 on completion of 20 years of service, with placement in Level-11 of the Pay Matrix and admissible pay fixation benefits under Rule-12 of the ORSP Rules, 2017.

You are, therefore, requested to take necessary action for fixation of their pay under MACP/RACP Scheme accordingly.
